1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Okay. It's 5:01. If
3 everybody would take their seats.

4 Okay. This is the final public hearing for
5 the budget for the year, and I'm going to turn it
6 over to Ed just as soon as he comes back.

7 OPENING REMARKS

8 MR. WUELLNER: My opening comments are
9 strictly related to the process under
10 Florida Statutes and a reminder to the board that
11 the process is obviously and clearly defined in
12 Florida Statutes.

13 You are required to discuss the millage before
14 you discuss the budget. You are required to adopt
15 the millage rate for the ensuing fiscal year before
16 you discuss and adopt a budget related to the --
17 upcoming year.

18 I do want to point out that unlike the first
19 budget hearing, the second budget hearing was
20 advertised, is required to be advertised. The ad
21 did appear properly in the -- in the St. Augustine
22 Record last Friday, the 17th, and we will show you
23 the affidavit of publication to support that, but
24 it was -- was properly noticed for purposes of
25 budget.

1 I asked Brad Wentz with Passero -- we didn't
2 have copies of the -- of the first page of the
3 budget available to the public -- for some reason,
4 we didn't get them copied before the meeting -- but
5 he's running them right now and they'll be here in
6 just a second for -- for others. So, if -- my
7 apologies. I thought we as a matter of practice
8 normally have them out.

9 In any case, I'm going to move along, if
10 you're all right with that.

11 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Uh-huh.

12 MR. WUELLNER: As -- as I mentioned, the first
13 substantive order is the millage.

14 The budget that we have built this year relies
15 on zero millage, so we without hesitation would
16 recommend the adoption of a zero millage rate again
17 for the ensuing fiscal year and would so recommend
18 that.

19 If the board would entertain, we can read the
20 resolution into the record, the proposed resolution
21 for adopting a zero millage rate, if that's the
22 board's desire and at which point you can open it
23 up to the public and --

24 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Okay. Do we need to read
25 it first or open up to public comment first?

1 MR. BURNETT: It's up to you.

2 MR. WUELLNER: It's really up to you.

3 DISCUSSION OF MILLAGE RATE BY AUTHORITY

4 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Okay. Bring it to the
5 board first. Board comments on the millage rate?

6 (None.)

7 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: None?

8 MS. LUDLOW: No comment.

9 PUBLIC COMMENT

10 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Public comment? I have no
11 cards. Anybody want to make a public comment?

12 (None.)

13 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Seeing none, we'll pass it
14 back to us. Looking for a motion.

15 TENTATIVE ADOPTION - RESOLUTION 2021-03

16 MR. OLSON: I move the adoption of
17 Resolution 2021-03.

18 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Okay. Doug, if you could
19 read it, and we'll need a second.

20 MR. MIRGEAUX: Second.

21 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: A second from Justin.
22 Doug, read it please.

23 MR. BURNETT: This will be Resolution 2021-03.

24 A resolution of the St. Johns County
25 Airport Authority of St. Johns County, Florida

1 MR. MIRGEAUX: Aye.

2 MS. LUDLOW: Aye.

3 MR. OLSON: Aye.

4 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Aye. Opposed?

5 (None.)

6 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Okay. It's passed
7 unanimately 4-0.

8 PROPOSED BUDGET - STAFF

9 MR. WUELLNER: Thank you. With the millage
10 rate put to bed, so to speak, we can now
11 substantively talk about the proposed budget for
12 next year.

13 I will focus my comments on the first page of
14 the draft budget, and happy to go into additional
15 detail should you have questions. Thank you, Brad.
16 Give you a second to get some of those distributed,
17 if you wish.

18 The first page of the budget, first part of it
19 is the revenues. Make the notation to you or
20 reminder that the revenues reflected in this
21 section are at the 95 percent level, meaning
22 they've been reduced from projections by 5 percent.
23 So, there is a -- a bit of a -- of a hedge, if you
24 will, from what the expected earnings are, just to
25 cover any anomalies that might occur in the ensuing

1 fiscal year.

2 With that, fuel is expect -- expected to be
3 \$354,721, leases at \$3,621,083, operating
4 agreements at \$236,071, for adjusted total
5 operating revenue of \$4,211,875.

6 Nonoperating revenues include our reserves
7 forward of \$3,500,000, zero revenue expected from
8 loans, grants projected for next year at the level
9 of \$1,625,000, for a nonoperating revenue total of
10 \$5,125,000. Total revenues next year are forecast
11 and expected to be \$9,336,875.

12 Moving to the expense side of the budget,
13 personnel expenditures, all items in that, at
14 \$1,331,898, operating expenses forecast at
15 \$1,609,900, and total operating and personnel
16 budget expectation at \$2,941,798. We have zero
17 debt service, as we carry zero debt. Reserves
18 expected at the end of next year at \$3,508,077,
19 capital expenditures forecast next year at
20 \$2,887,000, for total nonoperating expenses
21 forecast for next year at \$6,395,077, bringing a
22 total expense estimate for next year at \$9,336,875.

23 Mr. Chairman and members of the board, the
24 projected revenues and expenditures are in
25 agreement, and we would recommend the adoption of

1 this budget via Resolution 2021-04.

2 DISCUSSION

3 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Okay. Going to the board,
4 any discussion on the board, comments?

5 (None.)

6 PUBLIC COMMENT

7 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Going to the public, any
8 comments from the public?

10 TENTATIVE ADOPTION - RESOLUTION 2021-04

11 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Seeing none, bring it back
12 to the board. Do I have a motion?

13 MS. LUDLOW: I make a motion that we accept
14 the budget as presented.

15 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: Thank you.

16 MR. MIRGEAUX: Second.

17 CHAIRMAN MAGUIRE: And a second. Okay. Doug,
18 if you'll read the motion.

19 MR. BURNETT: Yes, sir. It would be
20 Resolution 2021-04.

21 A resolution of the St. Johns County
22 Airport Authority of St. Johns County, Florida
23 adopting the final budget for Fiscal Year
24 2021-2022, excuse me, providing for an effective
25 date.

1 Whereas, the St. Johns County
2 Airport Authority of St. Johns County, Florida on
3 September 20th, 2021 adopted for Fiscal Year
4 2021-2022 a final budget following a public hearing
5 as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

6 Whereas, the St. Johns County
7 Airport Authority has prepared a budget for the
8 Fiscal Year 2021-2022; and

9 Whereas, the St. Johns County
10 Airport Authority adopted the final millage rate
11 prior to adopting this resolution.

12 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the
13 St. Johns County Airport Authority of
14 St. Johns County, Florida that:

15 1. The annual budget estimates of revenues
16 and expenditures of the St. Johns County
17 Airport Authority for Fiscal Year 2021-2022, as
18 considered and acted upon, under, and by the
19 authority of the laws of Florida are hereby
20 ratified, approved, and adopted and the amounts of
21 monies set forth therein are hereby appropriated.

22 2. The annual budget of revenues and
23 expenditures adopted for the ensuing Fiscal Year
24 2021-2022 shall be attached to the minutes of that
25 meeting.


