Please note that the low bidder (McConnie Fence Co.) proposal has been rejected since it is deemed to be nonresponsive and irregular due to incomplete and missing forms from the Bid Form section of the Contract Documents. The missing and incomplete forms include the Statement of Surety's Intent, EEO Experience Certification, Subcontractor's and Suppliers, DBE Utilization Forms & DBE Good Faith Documentation, Certification of Bidder Regarding Tax Delinquency, and Statement of Bidder's Qualifications.

Passero Associates performed a review of Sterling Enterprises responsibility by researching the following:

- A detailed analysis of the proposal submitted by Sterling Enterprises, L.L.C, revealed no irregularities. The proposal appears to be fair and reasonable.
- Sterling Enterprises, L.L.C., is a registered Florida Limited Liability Company, EIN Number 20-0745205
- Sterling Enterprises, L.L.C., did not appear on the U.S. System for Award Management's (SAM) List of Debarred, Suspended, or Voluntarily Excluded Firms Ineligible for Federal Aid.
- Sterling Enterprises, L.L.C., did not appear on the U.S. Department of Labor's H-1B Debarred/Disqualified List of Employers or on the Willful Violators List.
- The Office of Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) for safety violations did not report any cases within the past five (5) years associated with Sterling Enterprises, L.L.C.
- Sterling Enterprises, L.L.C. has been a licensed business within the State of Florida since 2004 and has successful experience with similar projects.

A Bid Tabulation showing the bids received is enclosed for your review. The low bidder proposal has been rejected as explained above. Sterling Enterprises, Inc., is the next lowest bidder with a total Base Bid amount of \$1,698,834.00. The contractor construction budget programmed for the project is \$2,500,000.00.

Based on all this information considered, Passero recommends that the Base Bid be awarded to Sterling Enterprises, L.L.C., in the total amount of One Million Six Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$1,698,834.00), contingent upon concurrence by the Airport Authority's legal counsel and FAA funding.

Please note that Bid Additive No. 1 (Infrastructure at Gate 1-S) is not eligible for FAA funding and therefore not included as part of this recommendation of award. This recommendation of award is focused specifically on items to be included with the FAA grant application. It is recommended that the Airport Authority seek additional FDOT funding for Bid Additive No. 1 while awaiting an FAA grant offer. Should additional FDOT funding become available, then the Authority could consider including Bid Additive No. 1 in the Contract Award to Sterling Enterprises.
