Question 1

Is there an anticipated value for this contract?

Answer 1

The St. Johns County Airport Authority has not established a total anticipated contract value for this solicitation. This procurement is being conducted in accordance with the Florida Statute 287.055 (CCNA), which requires that professional services be procured based on qualifications rather than price.

Consistent with CCNA requirements, firms are evaluated and ranked based on demonstrated competence and qualifications. Compensation is then negotiated with the top-ranked firm to establish a fair, competitive, and reasonable fee structure.

This solicitation is structured as a continuing services contract, with work to be issued on an as-needed basis through individual task authorizations. As such, the total contract value will be dependent on the scope, timing, and number of projects assigned over the term of the agreement.

This approach is consistent with CCNA's competitive selection and negotiation framework and aligns with applicable FAA and FDOT procurement requirements for qualifications-based selection of professional services.
