

The St. Johns County Airport Authority established four (4) new Committees for support of, and Community Involvement in, the review and recommendation of the affairs of the Airport Authority in key areas of Governance and Operations.

**The Audit, Finance & Operations Committee** will review all aspects of the Authority's operational and financial activities, internal control, financial reporting, and the internal and external audits.

**The Master Plan Committee** will evaluate the current Master Plan & Airport Layout Plan and make recommendations on the future growth and development of the Airport.

**The Policy Committee,** upon request, shall review current policies, proposed policy matters/questions and submit recommendations to the Airport Authority. Proposed recommendations must be in compliance with FAA and FDOT regulations and improve overall operations.

**The Safety and Risk Management Committee** will act as an open forum for Authority employees, Airport tenants, SJC first responders, Air Traffic Controllers and members of the public, to provide input concerning the Safety, Health, Environment and Security matters in relation to the operation of the Airport.

The Airport Authority is looking for highly motivated volunteers with knowledge and experience in a wide variety of fields who are willing to contribute their time and effort in the success of our airport.
