1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN COX: First public hearing for the
3	2014-15 budget is now open.
4	MR. WUELLNER: Okay. Today if you don't
5	mind, today is the first public hearing. The
6	advertising for this is provided as a part of your
7	TRIM notification.
8	We will be discussing the millage rate by the
9	Airport Authority and then take public comment as
10	required, followed by adoption of the tentative
11	millage resolution, which will be Resolution
12	2014-02. Then we will discuss the budget. So you
13	have to do one before the other in terms of
14	adoption.
15	I can tell you that based on the input we were
16	given by board members and the board at the TRIM
17	hearing, the proposed budget excuse me, the
18	proposed millage rate for the upcoming fiscal year
19	is still proposed at zero. So there is no proposed
20	millage being made at this time.
21	MR. YOUMAN: Do we vote on that now, make a
22	motion? What do we do?
23	MR. WUELLNER: He has a resolution that if
24	that's your desire.
25	MR. BURNETT: Two things. One, let's take

- public comment on the resolution before we vote on
- 2 the resolution; and then two, I need to read the
- 3 resolution in it's entirety. So if I might,
- 4 Mr. Chairman.
- 5 It's St. Augustine-St. Johns County Airport
- 6 Authority Resolution 2014-02.
- 7 "A resolution of the St. Augustine-St. Johns
- 8 County Airport Authority of St. Johns County,
- 9 Florida, adopting the tentative levying of ad
- valorem taxes for Fiscal Year 2014-2015; providing
- 11 for an effective date.
- Whereas, the St. Augustine-St. Johns County
- 13 Airport Authority of St. Johns County, Florida, on
- September 8th, 2014, adopted for Fiscal Year
- 15 2014-2015 a tentative millage rate following a
- public hearing as required by Florida Statute
- 17 200.065; and
- Whereas, the St. Augustine-St. Johns County
- 19 Airport Authority proposed a millage rate of 0.0000
- and said rate does not exceed the rolled back rate.
- Now, therefore, be it resolved by the
- 22 St. Augustine-St. Johns County Airport Authority of
- St. Johns County, Florida, that the Fiscal Year
- 24 2014-2015 operating tentative millage rate is
- 25 0.0000 mills which does not exceed the rolled back

1 rate. 2 This resolution shall take effect immediately 3 upon its adoption. Duly adopted at a public 4 hearing this 8th day of September, 2014." 5 That would be the proposed resolution. 6 MR. YOUMAN: Is there a number to that 7 resolution? 8 MR. BURNETT: 2014-02. And with that, we'd be 9 ready for public comment, Mr. Chair. 10 CHAIRMAN COX: Got it. Open for public 11 comment on this agenda item. Mr. Martinelli? 12 MR. MARTINELLI: Bravo, Bravo. I think it's a 13 great -- 0000. 14 CHAIRMAN COX: Any further public comment? (None.) 15 16 CHAIRMAN COX: None seen. Tentative adoption. 17 MR. BRUNSON: I'll make a motion that we adopt 18 2014-06 (sic) as read by --19 CHAIRMAN COX: Hold on. 20 MR. WUELLNER: 02. 21 MR. BRUNSON: Hmm? 22 MR. WUELLNER: 02. 23 MR. BRUNSON: 02? 24 MR. BURNETT: 2014-02. MR. BRUNSON: 02. I thought you said 06. 25

1 Correction. 02, as read by attorney, for approval. 2 MR. YOUMAN: I second. 3 CHAIRMAN COX: Motion on the table. Looking 4 for a second. 5 MR. YOUMAN: Second. 6 CHAIRMAN COX: Second? Any further 7 discussion? 8 (None.) 9 CHAIRMAN COX: All in favor? 10 MR. CIRIELLO: Aye. 11 MS. BARRERA: Aye. 12 MR. YOUMAN: Aye. 13 MR. BRUNSON: Aye. 14 CHAIRMAN COX: Aye. The ayes have it. Motion 15 passes unanimously. Budget -- proposed budget. 16 MR. WUELLNER: Thank you. Same -- same 17 general process. We'll go ahead and walk through 18 the budget real quickly and it can be followed then 19 by discussion and public comment and then 20 adoption -- reading and then adoption of the 21 ordinance. 22 I have taken the opportunity to meet with all 23 of you individually. We've addressed all comments 24 and concerns related to the budget. This

represents the latest and greatest for lack of

1	better words relative to budget. If you will
2	would like to follow through it, I would I'll
3	work through the summary and if you have specific
4	questions, we can come back and hit those areas
5	as as you make me aware of that.
6	Basically we're we're that fuel this year
7	will generate \$126,586. Leases will generate
8	\$3,210,913. We will have operating agreements that
9	generate \$593,496. That total operating revenue at
10	100 percent would equal \$3,930,995. By statute,
11	we that is reduced to 95 percent. So we are
12	we reduce the revenue expectation by 5 percent.
13	That leaves that total estimated revenue at
14	\$3,734,445.
15	Nonoperating reserves include any kind of
16	loans, grants, and others. We have reserves
17	forward of \$5,108,275. We have loans equaling
4.0	

- zero. We -- we owe nobody any -- any money at this
- 19 point. We have proposed grants from FAA, FDOT, and
- the Florida Inland Navigation District, FIND
- district, that total \$4,233,050, for a total
- 22 nonoperating revenue expectation of \$9,341,325, for
- a total revenue estimate for the year, upcoming
- 24 year at \$13,075,771.
- On the expense side, we are estimating
- 1 personnel expenditures at \$1,167,642, operating

- 2 expenses of \$1,508,805. Reserves at the end of the
- 3 fiscal year would be \$5,204,063. And capital
- 4 expenditure for the upcoming year is proposed at
- 5 \$5,195,261. That results in a total expenditure
- 6 budget of \$13,075,771 which is indeed in balance
- 7 with the revenue expectation for the year. And I
- 8 would be happy to try and answer questions as you
- 9 might have them.
- 10 CHAIRMAN COX: Any questions or board
- discussion on the proposed budget?
- 12 MR. YOUMAN: No, I --
- MR. BRUNSON: Refresh my memory. The large
- drop -- jump in the grants, is it because of the
- 15 airline?
- MR. WUELLNER: No, sir. This is really just a
- larger FAA project that's available. So about \$3
- 18 million --
- 19 MR. BRUNSON: Okay.
- MR. WUELLNER: -- FAA for Taxiway Alpha.
- 21 MR. BRUNSON: Okay.
- MR. WUELLNER: That's the lion's share of it
- anyway. That's more detailed. If you desire that
- information, the second-to-last page that you have
- 25 there has how the breakdown of grant funds occurs
- 1 with FAA, FDOT, and FIND district as well as 5

- 2 percent DOT monies. Okay. 3 CHAIRMAN COX: Any further decision? 4 (None.) 5 CHAIRMAN COX: I'm open for public comment. 6 MR. YOUMAN: I'd just like to make a comment. 7 I went over the budget with Mr. Wuellner and we 8 discussed line items and personally I think this is 9 a very good budget. It's achievable and I would 10 vote for it. 11 MR. WUELLNER: Okay. Public comment? 12 MR. MARTINELLI: Just like I said before, this 13 is -- this is really a great budget preparation. 14 The crosswalk is clear, and I think kudos go to not 15 only Ed, but to Cindy, who has really done all the -- not Cindy -- Cindy W. 16 17 MR. WUELLNER: C.W. 18 MR. MARTINELLI: C.W. 19 CHAIRMAN COX: Too bad, Cindy. 20 MS. HOLLINGSWORTH: That's okay. 21 MR. MARTINELLI: So, job well done. Job well 22 done. 23 CHAIRMAN COX: Thank you, sir. Appreciate 24 that. 25 MR. BURNETT: And with that, Mr. Chair, if I
- 1 might, I'll read the proposed resolution.
